Boxing NS is a not -for- profit society which aims to educate youth and adults in recreational and competitive boxing. Due to the close working nature of the training all volunteers are required to complete a Vulnerable Sector Check and Child Abuse Registry Check at their own personal cost every two years.

It is the hope, but certainly not the expectation, that this letter may allow for a reduction or elimination of said costs to support persons interested in volunteering with Boxing NS, thereby helping to promote the sport.

Volunteers: Please note you are responsible for acquiring the above documents as per the expectations/application requirements of the organization completing your search. Recognize that the costs vary as do the applications requirements, often you will be asked to bring two pieces of government issued ID; one with a photo identification.

Upon return of the Vulnerable Sector Check and the Child Abuse Registry Check, please submit all documents along with your registration fee and completed Membership application to Boxing NS in advance of January 1, of the year you wish to register. Fast tracking of Membership applications will have an additional fee.

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
